

### SOMERSET COUNTY JR. LIVESTOCK SALE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION



**Number of Scholarships:** the number of scholarships which will be available through the scholarship committee unrestricted funds will vary each year depending on the money available in the scholarship account.

**Amount of award:** The amount of the award will vary each year with up to a maximum of \$1,000 each. The award will be sent to the post-secondary school of the selected recipients on October 1<sup>st</sup> of that year.

# Individuals who qualify may receive the scholarship only once.

# **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- 1. Applicant must be a resident of Somerset County, PA.
- 2. Applicant must be entering or attending a school of post secondary education and must be enrolled within the upcoming school year of receiving scholarship.
- 3. Applicant must have sold a market lamb, swine, goat, or steer at the Jr. Livestock Sale at the Somerset County Fair for the past three out of five years.
- 4. Applicant will be required to do a minimum of 3 hours of volunteer work at the fairgrounds to benefit the fair (use attached form). Hours done with a 4-H club or FFA chapter are not acceptable. All hours must be approved and signed by a fair board director.
- 5. Applicant will be required to submit a letter of recommendation. *Letter of recommendation must be in a sealed envelope and have an original signature no copies or emailed letters.* The letter must come with the application!
- 6. Applicant will be required to submit an essay of 300-500 words explaining what you have learned by showing and selling animals at the Somerset County Fair and what that experience has meant to you.
- 7. Applications will be available by contacting Doreen Jamison. See info below.
